Replayne Reveals ProjectISO's Official Title and Steam Store Page



Toronto, Canada — Replayne revealed today that their 3D platforming video game project, codenamed *ProjectISO*, has now been officially named *Dynacat* and has been confirmed for launch on Steam for both Windows and Linux. The <u>Steam store page</u> is already available and information about other platforms will be announced in the future.

Dynacat is a fast-paced 3D action platformer with an isometric perspective. The main objective is to speed through stages making use of platforms, springs and other elements to overcome obstacles.
